The public holidays come thick and fast at this time of year but your community shop will be there to supply your basic needs and support the various events going on in the village.

Following the Easter holidays, the next public holiday is on Monday 5 May when we celebrate the 80th anniversary of VE (Victory in Europe) Day. The Day, which commemorates the end of Second World War in Europe, actually falls on Thursday 8 May so the government has dedicated the Early May Bank Holiday – Monday 5 May – to nationwide celebrations where communities can come together to commemorate the Day. These celebrations will continue across the nation until 8 May. Wilstone's shop will be open from 9am until 12 noon on Monday 5 May.
